

THE CITY SYSTEM

NEW YORK CITY

The "City System" is a step-by-step device created for navigational purposes.

In accordance to simple observations and occurrences, the "City System" will determine each step in a series of steps that will define an experience through New York City.

To experience the "City System", it is recommended to have about \$4 - \$12 dollar bills and at least one hour of unhurried, purposeless time to amble through the City.

This "City System" has been created specifically for New York City as part of PSY-GEO-CONFLUX 2003, produced by ABC No Rio, Glowlab, and the Brooklyn Psychogeographical Association

The First Step:

1. Go to Union Square Park (14th St, between Broadway and Park Avenue South)
2. Stand on the stairs – in the middle about half way up.
3. When you have arrived at your starting location - go to **Page 2**

Page 2

1. Close your eyes and count to ten.
2. At ten – open your eyes and begin following the closest ambulatory person.
3. Follow the person to the nearest corner, then go to **page 111**.

1. Take a close look at the bicycle.

- If the bicycle has a seat –go to page 60
- If the bicycle does not have a seat –go to page 61

1. Go to the nearest public garbage can.
2. Note the amount of garbage in can: (choose best description)
 - Almost empty – go to nearest parking meter and p.16
 - About halfway full – go to p. 21
 - On the full side – go to nearest empty parking space for regular or commercial vehicles. Then go to p. 41

1. Stand at nearest bus stop.
 2. Count to 50.
 3. Get dollar out and ready.
 4. Examine dollar bills serial number. Note the numbers furthest to the outside of the serial numbers.
- If the left number is greater than the right number –walk the difference (L minus R) that many blocks to the left. Then go to p.11
 - If the right number is higher than left number – get on next bus and get off the number of stops equal to the difference (R – L) Go to P 34
 - If numbers are equal – put dollar on sidewalk. Go to p 68

Page 6

1. Stop! Do not move your feet.
 2. Look down and note the space between your feet
-
- If there is any garbage - go to p. 31
 - If there is any dried up bubble gum – go to p. 28
 - If neither of the above are present spread your legs as far apart as possible - go to page 69

Follow person with dog.

Continue following until the dog poops or barks- this may take a while, but be patient. All dogs poop and bark.

When the dog poops or barks – go to page 74

If you see a subway entrance before this happens - go to page 98

Follow the person with the stroller.

Make a note of the baby and the person strolling the baby.

- If the person and the baby look related, continue following until a subway system is located – go to p. 98
- If the person and the baby do not look related, continue following until another stroller is spotted, then repeat the above steps.

If stroller becomes unable to follow, go to p. 33

1. From where you are standing, look for a public place to sit. (This can be anything from a park bench to a stoop, wall, ledge, concrete structure...)
 - If one **is** vacant and you can sit down, go to p. 82
 - If one **is not** vacant and you cannot sit down *or* no public structure for sitting is in view, begin walking aimlessly until you find somebody sitting **alone**. When you have located a solitary sitting person- go to page 83.

Page 10

2. Begin walking EAST.
 3. Pay close attention to the mouths of every oncoming person that you pass.
- If you see somebody smiling or laughing, follow him/her to the nearest corner. go to p. 48
 - IF you do **not** see somebody smiling or laughing, continue walking EAST for three blocks. Go to p. 84

1. Stand at nearest corner and walk SOUTH to the middle of the block.
2. Stand with your back against the buildings so that you can observe pedestrians passing by.
3. Wait for **10** men to pass by.
4. Note the **11th** man.
5. If the **11th** man has...
 - Glasses – go to p.33
 - Hat – go to p.40
 - Mustache or goatee- go to p. 66
 - A dog go to p. 7
 - Any Combo of the 4 above- go to p. 20
 - None of the above, follow man for 2 blocks. Then go to p. 42 (If unable to follow stop and go to p.28)

1. On bus, spot the person you would believe to be the oldest.
2. Get off at the same stop as that person

If the person was wearing:

- A hat – go to corner in the direction the person walks. Then go to p.48
- Glasses – go to corner in opposite direction. Then go to p. 48
- Both or neither – cross street and go to bus stop of a bus going in opposite direction. Then go to p. 21

1. Get on bus
2. Sit in the furthest seat from the front.
3. At the next stop...
4. Note number of people to board bus.
5. Move one open seat forward for each person to board.
6. At the next stop, do the same steps above.
7. Keep doing this until there are no more seats open seats ahead of you. Then get off. Go to p.

1. From where you are standing, look for the nearest building **without** a visible fire escape.

- If there are no buildings **without** visible fire escapes, go to p. 35
- If you have located a building without a visible fire escape, go to p. 123

(NOTE: If parking meter is for “**one hour only**” – go to p. 93, if not continue with number 1 below.)

1. Find the nearest parking meter.

2. When parking meter is found, note the current amount of minutes until meter will expire.
 - If less than 12 minutes remains, go to p. 55
 - If 12 or more minutes remain, go to p. 51
 - If meter has already expired, go to p. 57
 - If meter is broken, go to p. 29

1. Begin walking SOUTH.
 2. As you are walking, keep your eye out for a vehicle parked in a spot with an expired parking meter.
- If you see a vehicle in this situation, add some time to the meter then – go to p. 55
 - If you have walked **TWO** blocks and not seen a vehicle in this situation – go to p. 89

1. Go to nearest corner.
2. Close your eyes and count to 10, when you reach the number 10 note the direction of the wind.
3. Walk against the wind until you see...
 - A restaurant – go to p. 27
 - A bus stop – go to p. 5
 - A person with a dog, stroller or guitar – go to p. 19
 - A subway system – go to p. 126

1. Follow the person spotted with dog- go to p. 7
2. Follow the person spotted with the stroller – go to p. 8
3. Follow the person spotted with the guitar until you see a subway– go to p. 98
If person with guitar becomes unable to follow – go to p.66

1. Go to nearest corner.
2. Begin walking SOUTH.
3. As you are walking look for the following.
 - A hot dog vendor – go to p. 58
 - An employee of any kind in front of their place of business- go to p. 59
 - A person walking and talking on a cell phone - Page 80

1. Find the nearest bus stop
2. Stand at bus stop and note the people waiting to board bus.
 - If there are more people shorter than you – go to p.94
 - If there are more people taller than you – go to p. 86
 - If there is nobody else, a tie or you just cannot tell – go to P105

1. Note N.Y. Daily News or N.Y. Post newspaper bin. (If newspaper bin is empty, go to P35)
2. Grab one of the newspapers.
3. Sit down in a comfortable spot nearby.
4. Look at the newspaper at your leisure.
5. **STOP if you hear a horn honk and go to p. 43.**
6. If you have finished browsing the paper - go to p. 70

Page 23

1. Stand at mailbox.
2. Look across street. If you can see:
 - A place that sells coffee- go to **p. 27**
 - A Pizza Place – **go to p. 129**

1. Stop and wait for a person with a hat or glasses to pass by.
2. When a person with a hat or glasses passes, begin counting people that pass by.
3. Stop counting when the next person with a hat or glasses passes by.

If you counted:

- Less than 10 people- go to p. 47
- 11-15 people- go to p. 48
- 16- 30 people- go to p.49
- 31-50 people – go to 55
- 51 or more people- go to 74

1. Wait for bus.
2. Get on bus and examine the reverse side of your Metrocard.
3. Find the sum of all the digits in the serial number (the 10 digit number under the word "Expires")
 - If the total is less than 25, exit bus and go to p. 74
 - If the total is 25 or more, exit bus and find the nearest coffee shop, go to p. 44

1. Count the number of people at bus stop.
 - If 1 – get on and off bus the same as that person -go to p. 48
 - If 2 – get on next bus – get off in 2 stops – go to 49
 - If 3 – get on next bus – get off in 3 stops – go to 105
 - If 4 - get on next bus – get off in 4 stops – go to 48
 - If 5 or more - get on next bus – get off in 5 stops – go to p. 104

1. Enter place that sells coffee.

If it you can see lottery scratchers – go to p. 71

If you cannot see lottery scratchers proceed to order a small cup of coffee.

If the person that gives you coffee is wearing “green” – take coffee and exit to nearest corner. **go to p. 129**

If the person is not wearing “Green” – take coffee and look for a place to sit. Then **go to p. 128**

From the spot you are standing:

1. Stop, close your eyes then count to ten. At ten, turn and look in the direction of the most prominent sound.
 - If the “thing” responsible for the sound that you heard is recognizable- go to Page 48
 - If the “thing” responsible for the sound that you heard is **not** recognizable – go to Page 82

1. Stand with back against nearest wall.
2. Count 15 people to walk by you. (If this takes longer than it would for you to drive home- go to P24)
3. Take an accurate notice of the 16th person.
4. If the 16th person...
 - Is wearing a hat- go to p. 51
 - Is completely bald – go to 41
 - Is both or neither of the above – go to P30

1. Stand at the nearest corner.
 2. Begin walking in search of the nearest “crosswalk”
 3. When you find the “crosswalk” cross it.
-
- If you had to wait for cars to stop, go to p. 41
 - If you did not have to wait for cars to stop, go to p. 51

1. Go to the middle of the block.

2. Stand with your back to the building and your front to the street.
 - If the sun is in view- go to P 68
 - If the sun is not in view- go to P32

1. Find the nearest tree.

- If the tree is has lots of leaves – go to p. 90
- If the tree does not have lots of leaves –go to p. 91

Page 33

1. Stop and go to the nearest corner.
2. From where you are standing look for the following.
3. Go to the page # determined by the first of the following "things" located.
 - A police car or police officer- go to p. 41
 - A woman in short skirt with high heels- go to p. 80
 - A dog on a leash- go to p. 7
 - A bearded man on a bicycle- go to p. 68
 - A guitar or guitar case- go to p. 19
 - A person with a cup of coffee- go to p. 124

1. Go to nearest corner.

2. Begin walking in the direction that is against the wind.

3. Continue walking until you see:

- A baby stroller– go to p. 19
- A taxi cab- go to p.38
- A hot dog vendor – go to p. 58
- A person walking and talking on a cell phone - Page 127

1. Stop and walk to nearest corner.
2. Begin walking in the direction of your birth.
3. Continue walking until you see a person smoking. Then go to p. 75

1. Stop and go to middle of the current block.

2. Find the nearest "man hole".

- If it reads "**Made in India**", go to p. 124
- If it does not read reads "**Made in India**", go to p. 51

1. Go to nearest corner.
 2. Look into the sky.
- If you see any flying objects, Find a nearby place to sit and go to p. 125
 - If you do not see any flying objects, look for the tallest building. Continue walking in that general direction, until you spot a leaf on the ground. then find a nearby place to sit, and relax
- go to o.125

(if you reach the building go to p. 52)

1. Begin walking NORTH.
2. As you are walking attempt to hail a cab.
3. When you are successful, get in the cab.
 - If the cab driver is wearing a hat, go to p. 101
 - if the cab driver is **not** wearing a hat, go to p. 102

1. Go to nearest corner.
2. Begin to walk WEST.
3. Count the trees growing on the sidewalk you are on.
4. Keep walking and counting until you reach the next corner.
5. According to the number of trees:
 - 0 –1 tree- go to p. 66
 - 2 – 5 trees- go to p. 81
 - 5 –9 trees- go to p. 28
 - 10- 11 trees- go to p. 40
 - 12- 15 trees- go to p. 35
 - 16 or more – go to p. 36

1. Stand on nearest corner and face the street intersection.
 - If you are a man- you will walk down the block to your immediate left in regular comfortable steps, walk the appropriate direction taking one step for every year you have lived. Go to p. 15
 - If you are a woman – you will walk down the block to your immediate right in regular comfortable steps, walk the appropriate direction taking one step for every year you have lived. Go to p. 24

1. Begin walking towards the nearest body of water or river.
2. Stop when you see somebody who is standing and stationary. – Go to p 59
(IF you reach the water, go to p 124)

1. Go to nearest bus stop.
 - If you do not have a Metrocard go to **page 14-** wait patiently
 - If you happen to have a Metrocard, examine the reverse side of it. Note the serial number. (10-digit number under the word Expires)
 - IF serial number is ODD – get on the next bus, go to p. **12**
 - IF serial number is EVEN- get on the second bus, go to p. **12**

1. Go to nearest corner.
2. Begin walking toward the tallest building in view.
4. If on the way to the building, you see:
 - A Coffee Shop- go to p. 44
 - A laundromat- go to p. 7
 - A deli / liquor store – go to p. 71
 - A bank – go to p 100
 - A solitary man with a tie, sitting – go to p. 54
 - A person with a dog- go to p. 7
 - Yellow flowers. – go to p. 28

(if none and you reach the building go to p. 51)

1. Enter coffee shop
2. Order a small coffee
3. Make a special note about the person who takes your order.
4. Sit and enjoy your drink
5. If the person who takes your order was:
 - Wearing a ring –go to p. 45
 - Has a pierced nose or eyebrow – go to p. 46
 - Has both or neither of the above, finish your drink then go to p. 55

1. As you are sitting and enjoying your drink, keep an eye on the front door. (If it is not possible to see the front door from your seat, get up and exit coffee shop and go to p. 34.)

2. If any of the following descriptions match anybody that walks in the door while you are sipping and enjoying your drink, do what is noted, If you finish your drink and no descriptions match anybody that walked through the door, exit café and go to p. 40.

- A man with a young child – go to p. 39
- A woman on a cell phone – go to p. 35
- A woman with her belly button revealed- go to p.43
- A man or woman wearing red shoes- go to p. 37
- A man or woman with an obvious injury- go to p. 36
- A woman with a green, orange or yellow sweatshirt- go to p. 33
- A person wearing a uniform of some kind- go to p.21
- A person wearing glasses, hat and any orange- go to p. 18
- A person who touches their face as they are entering – go to p. 32

1. As you are sitting and enjoying your drink, take a look around the café.
2. Take notice of all the people sitting down that are in view. Of the people sitting down in coffee shop, make a guess at which person you believe will be leaving first.
3. As you sit, watch this person.
 - If you observe the person do any of the following actions, go to the p. # given.
 - If the person does not do any of these actions and is going to leave the café, follow him/her outside and go to p. 49
 - Person touches nose- go to p. 35
 - Person scratches top of their head - go to p. 37
 - Person crumples napkin- go to p. 43
 - Person touches ear- go to p. 70
 - Person touches somebody else - go to p. 81
 - Person makes eye contact with you- go to p. 55

1. Stand next to nearest public garbage can.
2. Close your eyes and count to ten.
3. At ten, listen and note most prominent sound heard **at that moment**.
4. Walk in the general direction of the most prominent sound.
5. Keep walking in same general direction until you see:
 - A big blue public mail box – go to p.23
 - A person wearing red shoes –go to p. 38
 - A person smoking – go to p. 75

1. At nearest corner, put both hands above your head.
2. Note your shadow.
 - If your shadow is longer than 3 feet- go to p 64
 - If your shadow is 3 feet or less – go to p. 49
 - If no shadow, walk in the direction of your birth 1 block. Stand at nearest corner - go to p.34

1. Go to nearest corner.

2. Walk in the direction of the tallest building in sight.

3. Continue walking until you see a:
 - A hot dog vendor – go to p. 58
 - An employee of any kind in front of their place of business- go to p. 59
 - A person walking and talking on a cell phone - Page 127

IF YOU REACH THE BUILDING - GO TO PAGE 105

1. Add all the numbers together.

- If the sum is less than 12:
 - Stand with your back to the nearest structure behind you.
 - Follow the first man that passes with non-dressy shoes.
 - Follow him until you reach a corner, then go to page 37.

 - If the sum is more than 12:
 - Stand with your back to the nearest structure behind you.
 - Follow the first woman with non-dress shoes.
 - Follow her until you reach a corner, then go to page 51
- (Note: if non-dressy pedestrians become unable to follow, stop and go to page 31)

1. Go to the nearest corner.
2. From this corner, find the nearest reflection of yourself.
3. Look at your reflection:
 - If you can see moving object in your background, go to page 52
 - If you cannot see moving objects in your background, go to page 17

1. Stand at the nearest corner

2. Begin walking in the direction that you consider to be “home”

3. Keep walking until you see one of the following:
 - a Coffee Shop- go to p. 44
 - A solitary man with a tie, sitting – go to p. 54
 - A person with a dog- go to p. 19
 - Yellow flowers. – go to p. 53

1. Stand at nearest corner
2. Without changing your location, look for a flagpole.
 - IF you cannot see a flagpole, walk to the corner of the block to your left. Repeat steps.

NOTE: IF a flagpole is not seen from any of the corners on the block, go to p.62

3. After you have spotted a flagpole, go to p. 67

1. Note solitary man sitting with a tie

- If both of his feet are touching the ground, go to p. 81
- If only one of his feet are touching the ground, go to p. 89
- If neither of his legs are touching the ground, go to p. 64

Page 55

1. Find the nearest place that sells water.
 2. Purchase water
 3. Stand on nearest corner and drink water.
 4. Drink water at a normal leisurely pace:
- If you hear a horn honk before finishing, go to p 104
 - If you do not hear a horn honk and finish your water, go to P 105

1. Look around and try to spot a pigeon.
 - If 2 or more pigeons can be seen- go to p. 55
 - If less than 2 pigeons can be seen - go to p. 104

- If the car has received a ticket- go to page 56
 - If the car has not received a ticket begin walking away from the car.
1. Continue walking until the car is completely out of your sight, then go to page 56

1. Make a careful observation about the person:
 - If the person is sweating more than you are, go to p. 108
 - If you are sweating more than the person, go to p. 55
 - If you can't tell or not really sure, go to p. 76

1. Note the person:

- If the person is smoking a cigarette, go to p. 75
- If the person is not smoking a cigarette, go to p. 76

1. Note the type of lock used to secure the bicycle.

- If the lock is a Combination lock with 36 numbers – go to p 63
- If the lock is opened with a regular basic key – go to p 64
- If the lock is a serial lock with a number code –go to p 66
- If the lock is designed especially for bicycles – go to p 15
- If the lock is none of the above – go to p 4

1. Begin walking **North**.
2. Continue walking following any signs to the nearest Subway Station.
3. Find the nearest Subway Station.

- When you have found it go to **Page 98**

1. Stand on the corner.
2. Begin walking south. (Use your best judgement, do not ask for help)
3. Continue walking until you see:
 - A place that sells coffee – go to p. 27
 - A Subway Station – go to p. 98

1. Note the number that the combination lock is currently on. (This would be 12:00 on the dial)

1-9 go to p. 62

16- go to p.104

23- go to p.38

30- go to p.105

10- go to p.20

17- go to p.32

24- go to p.39

31- go to p. 61

11- go to p.21

1. Go to the nearest corner

 2. Look around you without moving your feet
- If you can see any flags - go to p. 20
 - If you cannot see any flags - go to p. 65

1. Begin walking any direction **but** NORTH.
2. Search for a Subway Station.
3. When you have found it go to **page - 98**

1. Begin walking any direction **but** EAST.
2. Search for a Subway Station.
3. When you have found it go to **page - 98**

Note the flagpole.

- If there is no flag on the flagpole, go to p 34
- If the flag is decorating a hotel, go to p. 78
- If the flag was decorating a moving vehicle of some kind, go to p. 38
- If the flag is decorating a restaurant, go to p. 27
- If the flag is decorating a building that is neither a hotel or restaurant, go to p. 29
- If the flag just doesn't fit into any of these categories, go to p. 105

1. Place a dollar bill on the sidewalk.
 2. Watch the dollar bill on the sidewalk.
 3. Follow person who picks up the dollar – follow for 100 steps.
- If person becomes unable to follow by walking stop - go to p 11
 - If 100 steps are taken go to p.30

1. Begin walking any direction **but** SOUTH.
2. Search for a Subway Station.
3. When you have found it go to **page - 98**

1. Begin walking any direction but WEST.
 2. Continue walking until you hear a **horn honk**.
- If on the way you pass a store that sells produce –STOP and enter the store- go to p. 71
 - If on the way you do **not** pass a store that sells produce – go to p. 105

Page 71

1. Enter the store.
2. See if you can buy a lottery “scratcher”.
 - If you can purchase a lottery “scratcher”,
 1. Stand directly in front of the entire selection.
 2. Buy the “scratcher” at the upper left corner.
 3. Exit the store – go to p 72
 - If you can **not** purchase a lottery “scratcher”, go to p. 77

1. Turn the lottery “scratcher” to the backside.
2. Note the most upper left digit
3. Lets assume that the number is **X**.
4. Begin walking NORTH and continue walking until:
 - a. you spot the number (**x**) – go to p. 120
 - b. you see a SUBWAY STATION - go to page 126
 - c. you spot a public structure designed for sitting.- p. 74

Page 73

1. Find a comfortable place to sit.
2. Drink the bottle of water at a leisurely pace... you've earned it.
3. When you are finished, go to p. 76

1. Sit and relax
2. Listen for a bird chirping
 - If you hear a bird chirping, consider this good luck.
3. Scratch your lottery “scratcher”
 - If you have won more money than you earned last year – go home.
 - If you have won less money than you have earned last year – go to p. 51
 - If you did not win any money at all, STAND UP and go to p. 97

Page 75

1. Count the number of times the person touches the cigarette to his/her mouth.

1. Remember this number.

2. Note what the person does with the cigarette when finished:

- If the person throws it onto the ground, go to p. 55
- If the person puts it in a ashtray or garbage, go to p. 66
- If you're really not sure what happened, go to p. 70

1. Stand up and stretch your body and muscles
 2. Go to nearest corner and look for person wearing orange. (this includes backpacks)
 3. Take 25 deep breaths as you look
- If nobody is found during the 25 breaths – go to p.51
 - If somebody is wearing orange – go to p 80

Page 77

1. Buy a single bottled water (if none- go to p.34)
2. Exit store - go to p 73

- IF there is not a doorman, go to p. 81
- If there is a doorman go to page. 90

Page 79

Look for the nearest person wearing an iPod.

IF you cannot locate somebody, exit subway station at next stop and go to page 122

When you find the iPod person, make a note:

- if the person is bobbing there head at all – go to page 130
- if the person is NOT bobbing there head at all – go to page 131

1. Follow the person that fits the description.
 2. Notice how the person walks.
 3. Try to figure out what leg the person favors while walking.
- If the person favors the **left** leg, follow him/her to the next nearest corner or until unable to follow, then go left to the next corner. go to p. 52
 - If the person favors the **right** leg, follow him/her for 2 more blocks, or until unable to follow- go to p. 51
 - If the person does not favor either leg, stop immediately and go to p. 84

1. Begin searching aimlessly for a person that fits the following description. You may sit and watch if you would like.

- Man
 - Wearing a tie
 - Black shoes
 - Glasses
 - NO facial hair
-
- When you spot this person, follow him to then nearest corner. Stop and watch him until he is out of sight, then go to page 51
 - If you have searched for more time than it would take you to drink a beer (12 oz.) go to p. 52

1. Find the nearest public structure to sit on.
 2. Relax....
 3. Try to crack your knuckles.
-
- If you cannot or will not, go to p. 36
 - If you can and do crack at least one knuckle, go to 109

Page 83

1. Note the person sitting
 - If you can see the person's socks, go to p. 64
 - If you can not see the person's socks, go to 104

Find the nearest stop light.

Stand at the base of the stop light pole.

Listen carefully to the electrical current of the light.

If you **can** hear it - go to page 65

If you **cannot** hear it - go to page 68

1. Get on the bus
2. Ride the bus to the next stop.
3. Note the **first** person to enter the bus through the front door.
4. Get off at the same stop as this person, go to p. 92

Page 89

1. Begin to look around you in every direction.
2. Search aimlessly for a CAB.
3. When you see a CAB **immediately** hold you breath and walk to the nearest corner.
 - If you made it to the corner without breathing, exhale and go to page - 70
 - If you did **not** make it to the corner without breathing, go to page - 69

1. Begin walking in the direction of your place of birth.
2. Continue walking until you pass or get passed by somebody that is shorter than you. Take note of the person:

- If the person is wearing high heels- go to p. 104
- If the person is wearing sneakers- go to p. 64
- If the person is wearing a tie- go to p.36
- If the person is crawling- go to p. 33
- If the person is none or any combination of the above- go to p. 40

Page 91

1. Begin walking NORTH.
2. Keep walking until you locate somebody that is sitting outside.
3. Go to the block that they are sitting.
4. Walk past the person that is sitting and continue to walk.
5. **Walk around the entire block.** When you get back...
 - If the person is still sitting outside- go to p.90
 - If the person is still outside, but not sitting- go to p. 37
 - If the person is still in sight, but not outside- go to p. 65
