WORKSHOP:

Venezuela native Jonathan Vizcuna will discuss his artistic journey and how he developed his series of animal sculptures made from paper. Students will create their own animal sculptures using one of his original designs.

In this workshop students will:

- learn about using paper as a medium for creating 3D art
- learn about techniques Jonathan uses to create his sculptures
- create an animal sculpture from paper and customize it to make it uniquely their own

Materials provided for recorded presentation: 1 template for creating paper animal sculpture per student
Additional materials needed: tape, glue sticks, markers, colored pencils, paint or any other media to individualize sculptures

WARM UP IDEAS:

- Discuss ways paper can be used to create a sculpture.
- Research how artists use technology to create art.
- Look up work of other paper sculpture artist and discuss their techniques.
